

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

For Worship

Because Covid-19 has changed the way we worship, we ask you to adhere to the following precautions for in-person worship:

- Masks: Face masks are now optional for all at this time, based on CDC recommendations and low community spread. Based on their risk tolerance, some churchgoers may continue to wear a mask and there are still masks available in the Narthex if you need one.
- Hand sanitizer is located at each entrance to the sanctuary.
- Social Distancing: Social distance at your own comfort level.
- Water fountains are still not in use for safety and hygiene reasons. Bring your own water if desired, and please remember no beverage except water is permitted in the sanctuary. Small bottles of water will be available if you need one.
- If you feel ill: Stay at home! Covid-19 symptoms include fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, and diarrhea.

WHAT TO EXPECT AT SERVICES

- Wonderful music: Hymn singing continues and special music is live along with the prelude and postlude.
- The offering plates will not be passed, but baskets are placed at all entrances to the church for your offerings. For information about donating electronically, visit the GIVING tab on our website or call the church office. You can also donate by mail or by drop-off at the office.
- There is still no passing of the peace.
- Pre-packaged communion elements will continue to be used.
- Sunday School for children, nursery, and in-person adult Learning Hour have resumed.
